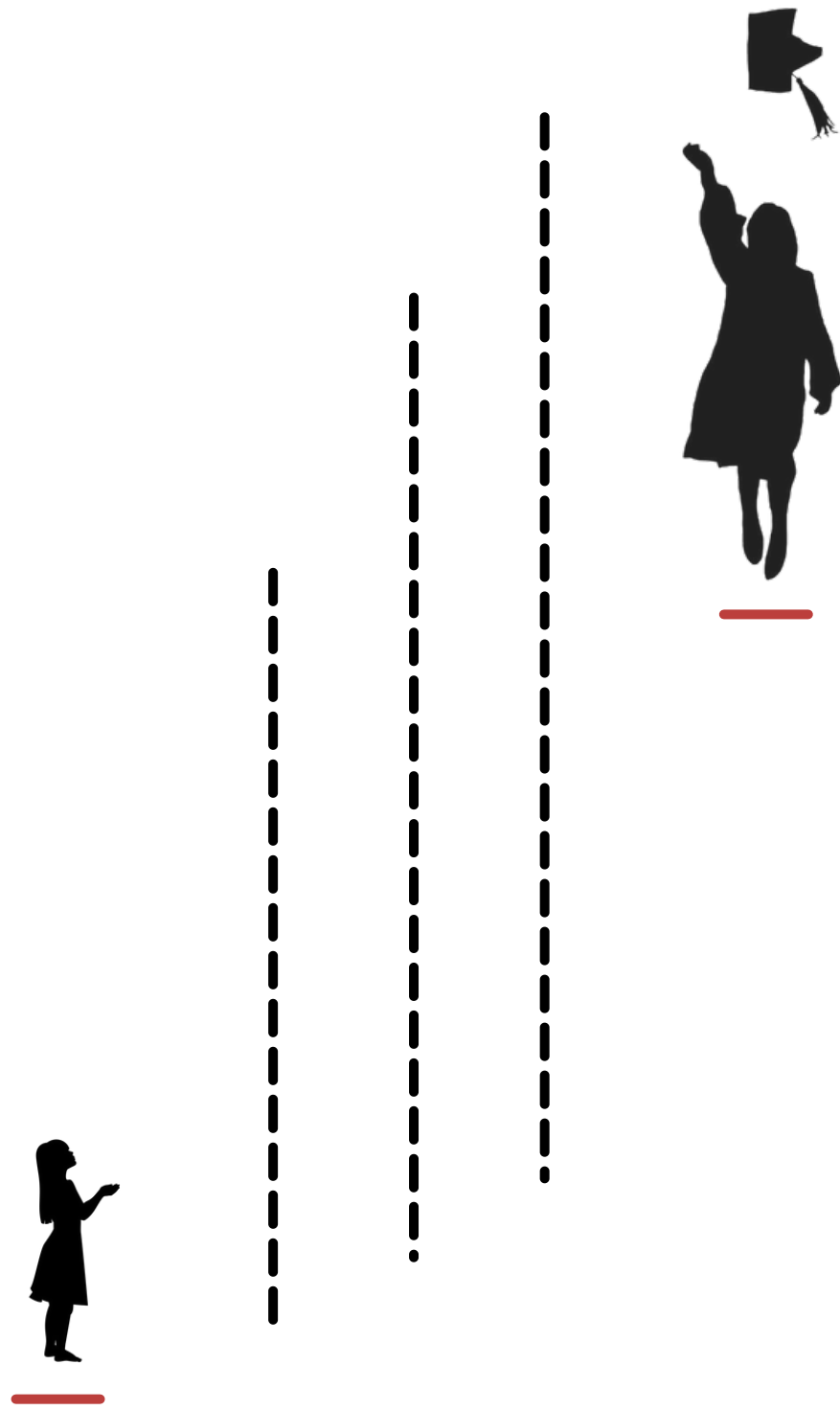

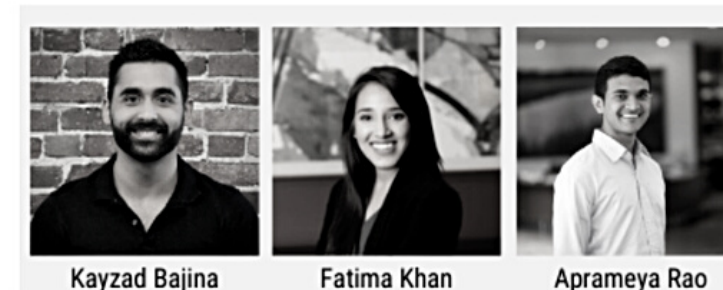

Through our **mentorship program**, we pair individuals with working professionals in their fields of interest on a 1:1 basis for personalized learning.

We give those interested in a sector or topic the opportunity to connect with and learn directly from those currently in those sectors. We also support professionals in giving back to their communities through advice, guidance, and mentorship.

The mentorship program is structured, time-specific, and supplements existing resources at dabbl and online.



The program has three objectives:

1. Connect students, recent grads, or those looking for a career change with experienced professionals in that sector
2. Provide a starting point for conversations on personal and professional development, joining new industries/sectors, and learning new skills (our mentors and mentees are free to, and encouraged to, continue their discussions beyond the 4-month cohort)
3. Provide an opportunity for professionals across industries and across seniority levels to share their knowledge and experience with those interested

Through these programs, we aim to empower young professionals to make informed decisions about their futures.
